Besuch von Sigma3D in Gescher 2021

On Thursday 28th of October, as a part of the course "Industrial Metrology", we headed to the company named Sigma3D to see industrial geodesy in action and to bring life to everything we learned in lectures so far. We gathered at 8:30 on a bright sunny day and arrived at the spot after a 1 hour drive. There we were greeted by Mr. Frank Mönsters (CEO of sigma 3D and a also former student of Hochschule Bochum). We were shown photo and video material from the sites and given a thorough explanation of servereal use cases and sigma 3D's worldwide projects. By visiting their laboratory, we saw a 3D hand held scanner, laser trackers and a structured light scanner. In a hands on example, we tried to capture a 3D model of a salt crystal. After a lunch break, we looked at the footage from field work at different VLBI telescopes around the world.
