## **Checklist for digital studying**

### **Technical equipment**

As basic technical equipment you will need:

- internet access
- digital terminal (e.g. laptop, PC, tablet)
- headset and microphone/headset/etc. for communication with lecturers/students
- webcam/ integrated camera
- access to a printer

There are notebooks, laptops and PCs with a webcam/microphone already integrated, but also external webcams with an integrated microphone. A headset provides the best results in communication for online courses, as there is no feedback.

### **eMail account**

Log in to your university [eMail account](#) (vorname.nachname@stud.hs-bochum.de): official communication with the examination office, lecturers and the university in general takes place exclusively via this way.

### **MyBO**

Log in to [MeineBO](#), the access data correspond to your login data in the applicant portal or in the university portal (self-given password). You may use the self-service function to download important documents, such as the semester ticket or matriculation certificates. You may also use it to access the exam organization, performance overview, and personal data management (e.g. in the case of a change of address), and you may have an overview on your re-registration status as well there.

## **moodle access**

Log in to [moodle](#), the university's learning platform. The access data correspond to your login data in the applicant portal or in the university portal (self-given password). Moodle is where the digital events take place. There you may also find learning materials of your department, interdisciplinary courses and also offers of other institutions of the HS BO. Usually you can follow the events directly in your browser (e.g. Firefox, Chromium).

## **Sciebo - The Campus Cloud**

[Sciebo](#) is the first non-commercial data cloud for students and scientists. Here you can exchange files with other students and work together on documents. Each participant has 30 gigabytes of free storage space at their disposal. The data is stored at German universities and the storage is subject to the requirements of the German Data Protection Act.
